

## *Descendants of Judith A. Wheeler*

### **Generation No. 1**

**1. Judith A.<sup>5</sup> Wheeler** (Archibald (Archer)<sup>4</sup>, Samuel G.<sup>3</sup>, Charles<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1833 in Cumberland County, VA, and died Unknown. She married **William P. Black** 12 Nov 1857 in Boone County, MO<sup>1</sup>, son of James Black. He was born Abt. 1836 in Missouri, and died Unknown.

Notes for Judith A. Wheeler:

The 1850 Census for Boone County, Missouri lists her age as 17, thus born in 1833. However Samuel J. Wheeler gives his birth date as June 10, 1833 in his Civil War records. Marriage Bond of their parents was dated May 28, 1832. The actual marriage could have taken place earlier. Census records are not always accurate concerning ages. We have been unable to trace Judith Ann Black beyond the 1860 Census. A James Black is listed on census page prior to Archibald on 1850 Census. There is a son age 16 named William, which may be the one that married Judith.

Notes for William P. Black:

A William Pierson Land record dated 1848, Boone County, Mo, may be that of father or relative.

William and Judith sold lot in Sturgeon, Missouri on April 23, 1858 (seeded in scrapbook).

He may be the son of James Black (1850 census) of Virginia who lived close to Archibald, with a son named William, born in Indiana.
