Pension Record and depositions for Rev. War of Allen, Pension No. R 9539

Virginia

On August 14, 1843, in Garrard County, Kentucky, Nancy Shrewsberry, being the widow of the said pensioner and being at the age of 74, appeared in open court and stated that her husband, Allen Shrewsberry had served in the brigade under the command of General Muhlenberg in the regiment under command of Col. Merriwether and also under command of Major Declannon and in the company under command of Capt. John Trigg and Lieutenant John Davis.

She also stated that he had volunteered in the month of August 1780 and that he had left the service 3-21-1781: and that he had enlisted in Bedford Co., Va.

She also stated that they then marched from New London down the south side of the James River to the mouth of the said river and there they then remained until the last of the month of February and they then returned through Petersburg to New London in Bedford County, Virginia and there the said pensioner was honorably discharged. He had volunteered for a tour of six months duration and finished that amount of time.

The said deponent, being the widow of the said pensioner, Allen Shrewsberry, also stated and swore that she had been married to the said pensioner on March 16, 1790 and that he had died 3-5-1843.

The affidavit of John Buford was also given at the same time and in the same place as the foregoing.

The said deponent stated that he has served together with the said pensioner and he also swore that in the neighborhood in which the said pensioner resided he was reputed to have served in the war of the Revolution.

This said deponent also stated that in the year 1791 the said pensioner and his present widow had been reputed to have been man and wife and he also stated that they, the said pensioner and his widow had cohabited, or lived together as man and wife within his knowledge.

The affidavit of Thomas Buford was also given at the same time and in the same place as the foregoing.

The said deponent stated that at one time and in the said county and state he had been well acquainted with the said pensioner and this said deponent also stated that the said pensioner and his present widow had cohabited or lived together as man and wife within his knowledge.

The said deponent also stated that the said pensioner, Allen Shrewsberry had died as his widow had stated in open court in her aforementioned affidavit.

The affidavit of Benjamin Schooler and Jesse Yantis was also given at the same time and the same place as the foregoing.

The said deponents stated that at one time and the said county and state they had been well acquainted with the said pensioner and they also stated that in the neighborhood in which the said pensioner resided he was reputed to have served in the war of the Revolution on the side of the United States.

On August 21, 1843 in Madison County, Kentucky, the affidavit of David Irvine was also give.

The said deponent stated that he was the clerk of the Madison County Court and he produced in open court the marriage Bond and marriage certificate of the said pensioner and his present widow.

The said marriage bond was signed by Allen Shrewsberry and Peter Taylor and it stated that the maiden name of Nancy Shrewsberry, the widow of the said pensioner, had been Nancy Wheeler. And the aforesaid marriage certificate was dated 3-16-1790.

On March 20, 1852, in Mercer County, Kentucky, the affidavit of Sarah Donoho was also given.

The said deponent stated that she was the only living child of the said pensioner, Allen Shrewsberry and his widow, Nancy Shrewsberry.

This said deponent also stated that her parents had been properly married in the spring of the year 1790 and she also stated that her father, the said pensioner, had died as had been stated and she further added that her mother also, being the widow of the said pensioner, had also died as stated\February 24, 1846.

This said deponent also stated and swore that her mother, Nancy Shrewsberry, had left as her only due and legal heirs and children Mary Shrewsberry, Milly Fleming and the said deponent herself, Nancy Donoho.

March 27, 1852, in Jefferson County, Kentucky, the affidavit of I. W. Sawtelle was also given. The said deponet, stated that he was a Notary Public in the said county and state and he certified and swore that both the said pensioner, Allen Shrewsberry, and his widow, Nancy Shrewsberry, had died as had been stated in the above affidavit of one of their daughters, Nancy Donoho.
